## 1 Instruction

### 1.1 Summary

USB VoIP Speaker Phone is a high quality and portable USB VoIP Speaker Phone with DSP voice processing technologies. It is the ideal communication solution for any mobile worker or company people to engage in hands-free conversation or conference calls.

### 1.2 Features

1. Ideal for group conference, free internet call and music enjoyment.
2. Due to 48KHz sample rate, presenting CD-quality music and high fidelity sound.
3. DSP built-in for echo cancellation and noise reduction.
4. Full duplex speakerphone with adjustable volume and mute control.
5. Convenient for private conversations with ear-phone.
6. Ideal for travel because of small size and light weight.
7. USB 1.0 & 2.0 compatible, Mac and PC compatible
8. Supporting Skype, MSN, Yahoo, AOL and VoIPBuster etc.

1. Windows 2000 SP4 and XP
2. 400MHz processor and free USB1.1 or USB2.0 port
3. 128MB RAM and 15MB free disk space

## **2 Using the USB VoIP Speaker Phone**

### 2.1 Keypad Instruction



#### **MUTE MICROPHONE**

Press to mute the microphone, press again to disable mute.

#### **MUTE SPEAKER**

Press to mute the speaker, press again to disable mute.

#### **VOL+/VOL-**

Adjust speaker volume.

#### **LED**

The indicator is activated when the USB VoIP Speaker Phone is connected to the computer.

- (1) The indicator will flash every 0.25 second when the speaker

is muted.

- (2) The indicator will flash every 1 second when the microphone is muted.

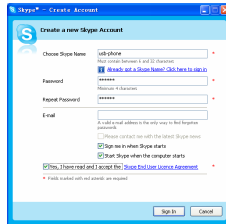
### 2.3 Run Skype

- (1) Download Skype software and install it ([www.skype.com](http://www.skype.com)).

The version must be 1.0.0.106 or higher.


- (2) Run Skype and log in with skype account.

You can create a Skype account as shown below:

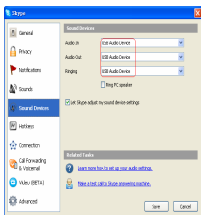


After software startup, the icon will appear to the system tray as shown below:



That indicates the Skype is successfully connected to Internet.  
If the icon is shown as , you have to check your Internet connection.

- (3) Make the USB VoIP Speaker Phone as sound device of Skype  
Click “**Tools/Option/Sound device**” to open the window shown as below:





Select **USB Audio Device** at **Audio In**, **Audio Out**, **Ring** tab and click **Save** button to save the setup.

## 2.4 Call Skype user from Skype contacts

- (1) Select a contact from Skype contacts.
- (2) Double click/contact to call out.

## 2.5 Answer a call

- (1) When a call comes in, the USB VoIP Speaker Phone will ring.

Click  to answer the call, or click  to refuse the call.


- (2) Use ear-phone, to keep the calling privacy.

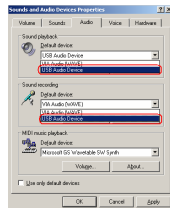
## 3 FAQ

### Problem 1

I can't play music through my USB VoIP Speaker Phone?

#### **Solution**

Go to “Control Panel” -> “Sound and Video” () -> “Audio” on your computer. The preference device of “**Sound Playback** and **Sound Recording**” should be “USB VoIP Speakerphone” in the XP system or higher and “USB Audio Device” in the Windows 2000, as shown below:



### Problem 2

I can't adjust the volume of USB VoIP Speaker Phone by key?

#### **Solution**

Make sure the preference device of “**Sound Playback** and **Sound Recording**” is “USB Audio Device”.
